


WHO ARE WE ?

FFA was created in February 10th 2007 by a gathering of 10 french teachers of Paris Sorbonne University, helped by their classes, by 60 french high schools and by retired french teachers.

All years long, we teach migrants writing, reading, speaking french and the french history. Every day, 8.000 migrants arrive in Europe.
We accommodate in centers where migrants are dispatched in differents classes of 10 persons. We give them books, notebooks and pencils so that they can study in good conditions. They have 8 hours of French by week. Thanks that, all the people who don't have education, they are no more considerate like illiterate.
